

Dittmer Project – Community Update

Dear Resident,

Welcome to our second Community Update on the work we are doing at the Dittmer Project and our activities within the local area.

Our surface drilling program commenced in June and unfortunately, due to the wet weather and some difficult ground conditions, progress with this work has been delayed. However, we remain on track to complete the drilling program next month (October).

We are aware that the drilling may be disruptive, and we are doing all we can to minimise the impact on local residents, including limiting the drilling activities to 7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday and installing noise barriers around the equipment where possible.

We acknowledge that the terrain and weather conditions can affect the direction of noise during the day. We would like to thank everyone for their patience while we complete this work.

Other Works

We are currently working with the Department of Environment and Science and Innovation (DESI) as well as Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service (QPWS) and the Whitsunday Regional Council on applications for works around the historic mine area and options to remediate areas of existing workings and equipment left behind from these historic activities.

This includes the possibility of re-establishing the State Forest access outside of town to remove mine traffic from the township. We will keep the community updated on these discussions as they progress.
